












## **Job Trends**




## **Unemployment Rate Trends**

Tangipahoa Parish, LA had a September 2021 unemployment rate of 6.00%, decreasing from 6.75% 5 years before.






#### **Millennials**

Tangipahoa Parish, LA has 29,019 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 28,184.




















